



FIRMWARE REINSTALLATION IN DVRs

Important: Each DVR model has a different firmware version, in case of file or save it for future use, we recommend separate folders depending on the model of DVR, this is because the name of the firmware called "UPDATE" will be the same for all DVR models, but the file content is what makes the difference. The name "UPDATE" is what the DVR to recognize the file for reinstatement.

Do not interrupt the process of reinstallation at any time until it is completed. Do not switch off the DVR or disconnecting power while running the reinstallation.

Do not remove the USB until the process is completed, OK is pressed, and the DVR is restarted.

STEPS TO REINSTALATION.

Firstly be sure to connect the DVR to a backup power source, to avoid the interruption of electrical power in case of failure thereof.

1. Depending on the type of DVR, copy and paste the file named "UPDATE" on a USB stick.
2. Insert the USB stick into one of two USB ports that are free in DVR.
3. Access the DVR menu and go to the INFO submenu, then VERSION, and press START.
4. A progress bar began to load the file, which when finished will be asked to press OK to restart the DVR.

Misapplication or error in the procedure can damage the main board definitely making it unusable and causing irreparable harm, which would incur the loss of warranty.
